But, despite a bruising, negative campaign, 40 per cent of Australians – and 45 per cent of Victorians – voted to support an Indigenous Voice to Parliament.

For Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples, debate around the referendum and the no result have opened wounds, leaving us raw and bereft. The true impact will become evident only in the coming weeks, months, years.

But we are strong. We are proud. We are resilient. We will not let the referendum results distract us from our work.

We will continue to support our community. We're getting on with the job of healing Country and healing Dja Dja Wurrung People.

This November, DJAARA will celebrate the 10-year anniversary of the signing of our Recognition and Settlement Agreement with the State of Victoria in 2013.

Through our RSA, we are, increasingly, at the table with government and leading work on Country.

We have grown, over the past decade, from a small organisation to one of Bendigo's large employers, with more than 200 staff.

Dja Dja Wurrung People have more opportunities to heal Country, practise Culture, develop careers, build businesses, participate in community.

When Dja Dja Wurrung People are strong, Country is strong. When Traditional Owners are empowered, great things happen - not just for our own communities, but for all.

This November, we will reflect on and celebrate our significant achievements and look ahead to how we will continue to make still greater contributions to our community.





Five years of Joint Management

In another milestone, the Dhelkunya Dja Land Management Board (DDLMB) recently celebrated five years of Joint Management.

The Board was established through DJAARA's Recognition and Settlement Agreement (RSA) to develop a Joint Management Plan for the six Dja Dja Wurrung parks. The parks were returned to Dja Dja Wurrung People for Joint Management in 2013 as part of the RSA.

The DDLMB's Joint Management Plan was adopted in 2018. Since then, the Board has worked closely with Joint Management partners, DJAARA, DJANDAK, Parks Victoria and the Department of Energy, Environment and Climate Action, to oversee and support the Plan's implementation.
